Who, How, and Why We Serve

When disadvantaged youth receive academic support and positive life coaching, they are more likely to achieve academic success, enroll and complete college. We strongly believe that education is key to breaking the cycle of generational poverty.

We work with teachers and school counselors to identify disadvantaged students who can benefit most from college preparatory mentoring. At application parents agree to attend our Parent Workshops for each session their student participates in. Family involvement is important to the success of our students.

With the help of generous financial supporters and volunteers, our goal is to serve over 100 students and families each school year.

Facts

- Low educational attainment is highly predictive and symptomatic of households in poverty.
- Without positive intervening factors or influence, poverty typically becomes generational.
- Equally, households with one or more parent with a college degree are more likely to have children who attend college.

Summary of Programs

Future Collegians (FC) is our middle school program, consisting of four (4) six-week sessions that offer structured enrichment in the areas of education, physical fitness, and nutrition. Our educational component focuses on three areas of development: Life Skills, Academic Support, and Career Exploration.

Scholarship Game Plan (SGP) engages high school students and families. In addition to college tour road trips, students receive scholarship and college planning assistance. Most tangibly, SGP students receive access to valuable academic tutoring and college entrance test prep classes for the SAT and ACT.

Parenting Workshops (PW) make our program different than most, and we believe it makes our students more likely to succeed. The program helps parents with information and resources to pursue the dream of a college education for their child. Topics include additional educational resources, financial planning, financial aid, and scholarship opportunities..

Prep For Success (PFS) is a fund that allows more low-income students to receive the **critical benefit of professional** tutoring and college entrance test preparation.
